



The Archive of the Autonomous Region of Madrid safeguards the records generated by the Government and the Regional Administration of Madrid that are considered as intermediate and historical archives.

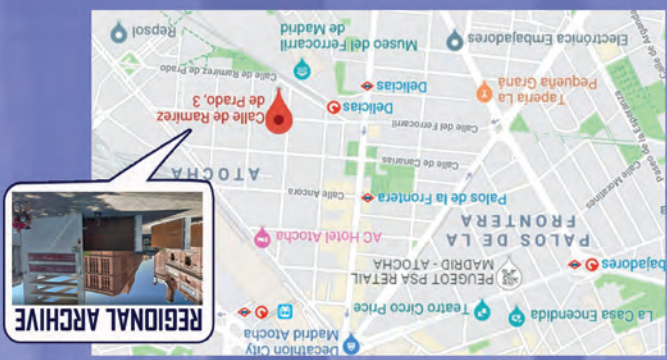
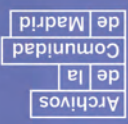
This Archive also holds the records produced by the former Provincial Council of Madrid and the historical archives of Madrid municipalities which, after a subsidy, are deposited for storage.

REGIONAL ARCHIVE OF THE AUTONOMOUS REGION OF MADRID

The headquarters of the Regional Archive of the Autonomous Region of Madrid opened in April 2003 and consist of four buildings linked together. These buildings have a surface of almost 29,000 square metres and are part of a space called "Complejo El Águila", which was named after the brewery that was formerly built there.

Thanks to the rehabilitation promoted by the Regional Government of Madrid, this old factory complex is currently one of the most important examples of Madrid's industrial architecture of the early twentieth century and of its adaptation for administrative and cultural purposes.

ARCHIVE COLLECTION

Nowadays, this large archive building houses an approximate volume of 56,000 linear metres of records, whose extreme dates begin in the fourteenth century and end in the early twenty-first century. All collections are equipped with control and description instruments that allow their location and, if necessary, their consultation.

These records are organized into five large groups of collections: Collections from the Autonomous Region of Madrid, Collections from the Provincial Council of Madrid, Municipal Collections, other Collections and Private Collections. The Archive of the Autonomous Region of Madrid also safeguards reproductions in different media formats (digital and microforms) of records that belong mostly to municipal archives dated between 1235 and 2009.

SERVICES

- Direct consultation of free access records.
- Searches of records to users when there are access restrictions that prevent direct consultation by themselves.
- Temporary loan of originals and delivery of digital reproductions for administrative and / or exhibition purposes.
- Reproduction of records.
- Auxiliary library.

ACCESS

Access to the Archive is free, upon presentation of the Identity Card, passport or similar document.

No special permit is required for consultation of records. Restrictions for this consultation are those established by the current legislation on access and derived from the conservation status of the records.
