THE PROJECT

You want to discover South-West of France, its heritage and history? You are interested in heritage and you wish to volunteer in a restoration project? Come and join The Saint-Georges Church in Calhabet restoration project, in the heart of Frespéchois, where craftsmen and women will be pleased to welcome you and transmit their know-how.

The Lo Reviscol association was formed in 2016 with the aim of saving this building. After two volunteer projects, the walls are now watertight and some sections have been rebuilt... Come and volunteer in that project where there is still a lot to be done to save San Jordi!



TECHNICAL WORKSHOPS

The Saint-Georges Church in Calhavet is an ancient Romanesque structure that has suffered damage over time and throughout history. This small chapel was burned down during the Wars of Religion, restored, and used until the 20th century, when it gradually fell into disrepair.

This year's project is an ambitious one: rebuilding the church's bell tower! Typical of the region, built in a single section to minimize the number of stones needed, these bell towers are an economic and artistic feature, and they are a symbol of our churches' identity. Still standing less than 30 years ago, only the base remains today. This year's project therefore aims to restore the bell tower to the church!

On the agenda: masonry and stone cutting.
