

THE PROJECT

Are you interested in traditional marine heritage and event organisation ? In this project, you will volunteer with Les Chantiers Tramasset to help them in organizing its flagship event: "La Rencontre des Bateaux en Bois et autres instruments à vent" (The Meeting of Wooden Boats and Other Wind Instruments). Les chantiers de Tramasset (1837) is a unique site. Listed as a Historic Monument, it is the oldest shipyard in France still in operation. The association was founded in 1997 with the aim of promoting river heritage and running awareness-raising and heritage outreach activities throughout the year.

TECHNICAL WORKSHOPS

During this workshop session, you will participate in the organization and set-up of the event (technical and logistical set-up, stage, signage, organization of the reception of the public and artists, etc.), and a woodworking and scenography workshop will be scheduled to showcase the association's traditional boats, which will be sailing for the occasion.

During these nine days, you will be fully integrated into the life of the association and will meet its members and the village residents. You will be supervised by professionals in the field of cultural and heritage events.

DAILY LIFE

Work days begin at 9:30 a.m. and end at 5 p.m. The schedule for workshops, outings, and rest periods is decided through discussion and collective consultation. Daily life and various tasks are organized and carried out collectively by the supervisory team and participants.
