TECHNICAL WORKSHOPS

An initial project to consolidate part of the polygonal enclosure (shell-keep style) that once enclosed the castle's upper courtyard.

The 2026 project is a continuation of this work. You will continue the restoration on the same section of curtain wall, interior and exterior faces and top (with a slight overhang). You will learn and practice traditional construction methods (lime mortar, wall assembly, introduction to stone cutting, etc.). An archaeologist will have carried out photogrammetric surveys beforehand, which they will present to you along with other methods used in architectural archaeology.

DAILY LIFE

The time allocated for work is around 30 hours per week in the mornings. Afternoons, evenings, and weekends are set aside for other activities.

You will take turns preparing meals as a team. This will give everyone the opportunity to share recipes from their region!

WHAT DO I NEED ?

Sleeping bag, towel, and toiletries. Worksite and comfortable clothing, protected shoes, work gloves, swimsuit, hat, sunscreen, insect repellent.
